County & Community Reports:

1. Mayor's Office: Beth Graham – Wasatch Canyon's Symposium March 26th everyone is invited. Year-end reports are due.
2. West Township Representative: Greg Schulz – Legislative session is going, Fireworks Bill has been passed to change back to shorten the selling season. There may be a bill dealing with incorporation to lower the threshold for incorporation.
