

MAGNA TOWN COUNCIL
Regular Monthly Meeting
October 3, 2013

Presiding: Jeff Senten

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm with 15 citizens in attendance. Jeff Senten offered a payer. La Dell Bishop led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mention was made that the Mayor's attendance will be postponed until next month.

Minutes for the September meeting were presented. Boyd Smith made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Kelly Killpack seconded. Motion passed.

Jeff Senten stated that he has been working with the Miner Hospital to do a future presentation next month.

Committee Reports:

1. Public & Government Relations (Kelly Killpack): Nothing to report

Arts Council (Wes Furgason): Not available

4th of July (Elizabeth Parkinson): Not available

2. Schools, Library & Recreation (Tory Allred): Absent. Star reported that she received a letter from youth services that they will be working with the school district to create a community learning center and will begin to have meetings starting next week. Cyprus was happy about the unveiling of the "C". Granite was suppose to report but were not present. Discussion was made about the grading system that came out, but without school district present, understanding was still desired.
3. Health, Welfare & Environment (Jeff Senten / Russ Dobesh): Wanting to look at tailing ponds of Kennecott. Piper Rhodes introduced herself as the representative for Kennecott

Special Reports Nancy White presented herself as the contact for U.P.D. graffiti removal. Starr addressed the members from the community council that were present, discussing a few weeks ago at the community council's meeting when code enforcement was mentioned pertaining to parking ordinance came out. The county told the town council that it would not be enforced unless it was reported. Todd has found the tape that discussed this issue with 12 minutes of discussion between Paul Bringhurst and Nancy Mormon. The town council will get that information to the county to show what we were told.

Public Comments: Rocky Montoya from Magna Christian Fellowship came to present an idea for an outreach of

a free concert asking to borrow stage equipment. Concert is scheduled for November 2nd from 12:00-6:00 at Copper Park. Kelly Killpack made motion to allow request. Mel Palfreyman seconded. Motion passed. Discussion was made that protocol needs to be established for use of equipment. Sally Marelius of 2915 S Patricia Circle spoke due to concern for the possible construction of a Wal-Mart Fresh Market in the area. The council expressed understanding for her concern, but the council has never been presented with anything concerning the plans. Todd Richards presented himself for consideration running for a position on the Magna water board along with Georgia York and Mick Sudbury.

County & Community Reports:

1. Mayor's Office (Celina Milner): Not available.
2. West Township Representative (Greg Schulz): Not available.
3. U. P. D.(Chief. Jon Fassett): pursuit September 11th male was harassing a female. Pursuit began at 201 at about 80th West. Suspect hit a police car, and eventually had to be tazed, and was then taken into custody. On September 28th. Officer Chante Julius was able to identify a bank robbery suspect in a home. Containment was set around the home and suspect was taken into custody. Kearns has seen more graffiti. Dogtown and 38th street gangs have been having revelry. A juvenile has been arrested that was responsible for a good amount of tagging. The Catholic Church robbery investigation is still ongoing, but there are some very good leads. Tours of Cyprus were conducted to review the school for their operation with UPD. Training of a new secretary due to the previous secretary getting a promotion will be taking place. Two new officers that were in training were chosen for the Kerns/Magna precinct. Cody Pender and Cecilia Fowler.
4. U. F. A.: Not available

Planning & Zoning (Todd Richards, Jeff Larsen): Rezone continued from Sept 12th and Christopher Clifford from R1-8 to R1-6. Proposal coming to redefine allowances of animal and fowl for food to change from permitted to conditional. Recommendation was made to draw up a letter to explain the feeling of the council that this proposal is concerning to us and we at this time we do not feel we should support it, instead keeping the current guidelines. Jeff Larsen made motion to draft a letter and Starr seconded, motion passed. There are many detention ponds that have weeds and need to be maintained. At 3500 and 7200 S. corner approach by 7-11 should be taken out for safety of traffic.

4. A.C.C.T.: (LaDell Bishop / Mel Palfreyman): Annual meeting with county council was on September 24th. Bicycle best practices booklet was discussed. Mayor McAdams has an idea to make one large "city" for all of the non-incorporated areas. This is directed to Salt Lake County. No other county areas would be affected. This would add another layer of government. This would create wall to wall cities.
5. Finance Committee (Todd Richards): Financial Statement (See report attached for August and September): Approve to move money in budget to cover Night out against Crime shortfall, pay for cartridges, and bills. Boyd made a motion to approve payables and Mel seconded, motion passed. Todd brought up discussion asking for approval to move storage facilities. Motion made by Starr and seconded by Mel to accept proposed budget, motion passed.
6. Presidents Report (Jeff Senten) Magna is a great place. Many things are going on but not all comes to the council for approval or discussion. Wishing Todd and Starr well for the road to recovery.

Special Orders: Two people are needed to assist with the CDBG grant: Community Development Block Grants. Two meetings in October. Start in January meeting from 11:30- 2pm, once a week. Discuss what the money needs to be spent for and if it is being spent as it was discussed. Starr took the name possibilities for the representatives.
